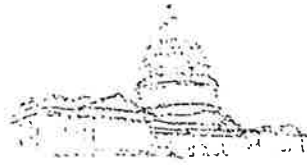

HISTORY

This history of Oscar Bird Wood shows who we are and where we came from. As most of you know our past tells a lot about our personality, our physical appearance and our dreams and aspirations for the future. In knowing about our past, we can understand and see more clearly the reason why we act or do the things we do. The past is the rich inheritance dictated to us through our upbringing, which teaches us our moral and spiritual values. These values determine what we do and much of who we are. Therefore, we are indebted to our past, to Oscar Bird and Annie Mariah Wood. We are deep;y enriched by our ties to them.

Our roots in America trace back to a large, mixed-blooded group of people who settled in North Hampton County of Conway, North Carolina. As many of you who live in North Carolina know, it is a very rich land that has plenty of natural wealth, trees, abundant wild life, and easy availability of fresh water. The North Carolina Indians who first lived there were invaded by European nations such as France, Spain, and Britain who came to this state more out of economic motives than for religious freedoms as we were taught in our history books.

The question of where the Wood name came from or more precisely, the birth parents of Oscar Bird Wood might never be answered. Was he a child born of freed black slaves? Was he a child of Mulatto or Black and Indian heritage? In 1741, an act was passed that said children of servants in North Carolina took the status of their mother. Most often slaves took the names of their masters, especially when the master was their father. However there are no known records to identify the birth parents of Oscar Wood.

To date, the first known written documentation of Oscar's existence is found at the National Archives in the 1870 census records. The record shows Oscar as living in the household of William Britton (age 33), along with his wife, Laura and daughters, Mollie and Rosa. In this document, Oscar's name was written as Bird Wood, his race Mulatto/White and his occupation was listed as a house laborer. In the 1900 census records, Oscar told the officials his birth date was March 1855, therefore he would have been age 15 during his inhabitancy in the Britton household.

One significant way in which land and freedom from slavery was acquired was through intermarrying. This was not the case for Oscar because it is stated in the 1880's census and on Oscar's marriage certificate to Annie Mariah Stephenson, that he married a colored woman. At ages 15 and 24 Oscar is listed in the 1870 and 1880 census as "Bird Wood" and in the 1900 census he is listed as Oscar Wood. In 1902, Oscar purchased a tract of land, about 160 acres, for \$700. This was quite a large tract for a Black person to own at that time.

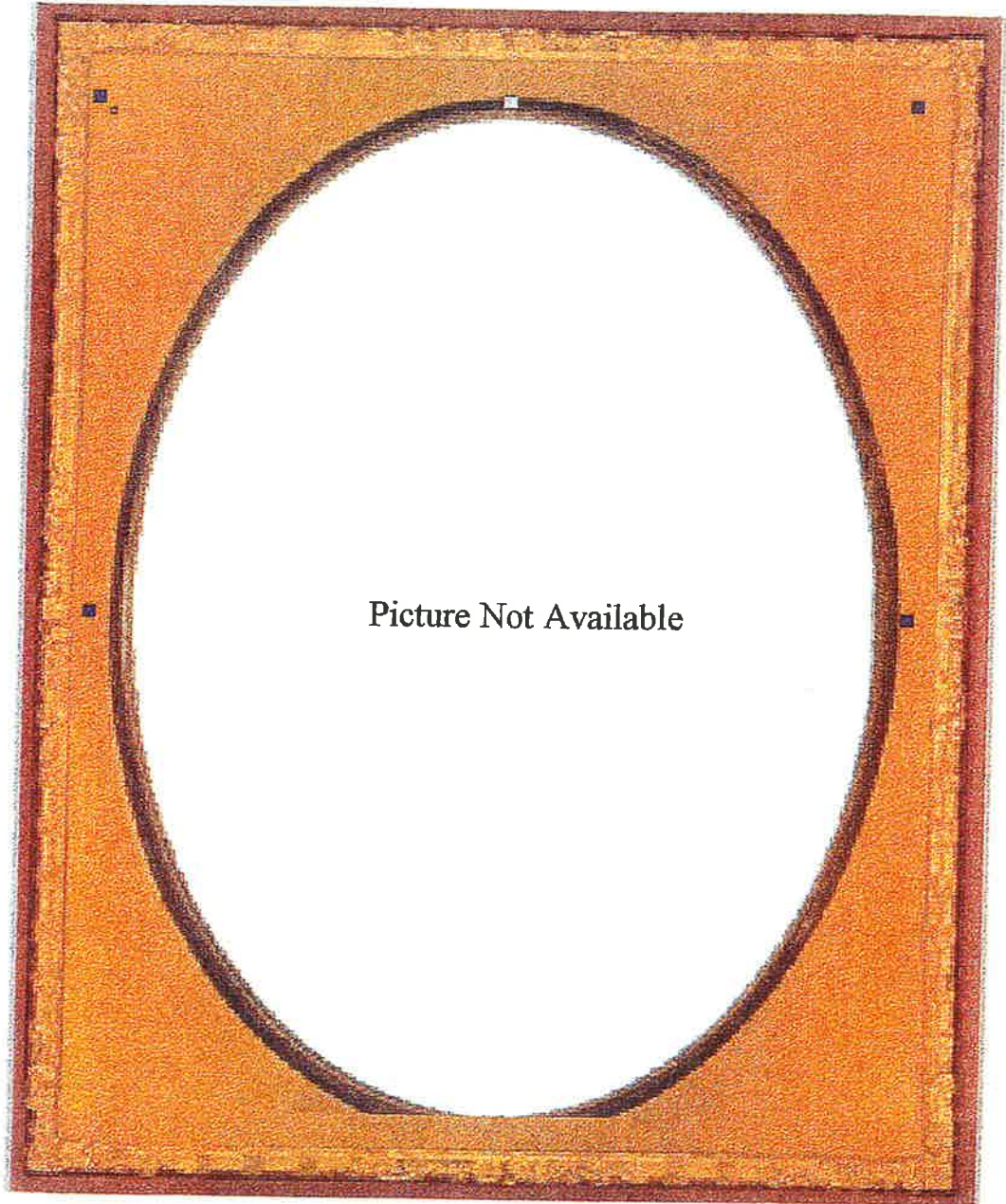
Oscar Bird Wood and Annie Mariah Stephenson were united in Holy Matrimony on January 15, 1878. Of this 12 children were born. Eight of the children lived and their names are: Charles, John, Viola, Aleathia, Spear, Jesse, Lorenzo, and Millard. Branching from those eight children are seven hundred people representing seven generations of descendants of Oscar Bird and Annie Mariah.

Oscar Bird Wood was a God-fearing man who established the cornerstone of his family in Zoar Baptist Missionary Church. Within this church Oscar and family planted their roots and cast their hopes and their dreams. His belief and desires of what a community ought to be literally became a part of his life. To this day Bird's name is listed as one of the original deacons and founding members of the church.

Oscar and Annie lived their entire lives in Conway. They built their second home on their property and this house still stands today. The documented grave sites of Oscar, Annie and several of their children are still manifested in the rich soil where Wood family members still abide and own the house and property where Oscar and Mariah lived. The descendants of Oscar still pay homage and give respect to a noble heritage during many visits to the church, to the grave site, and to the warm-hearted family members who have acted as the launching pads for many successful adventures to other parts of the country. Surely the wisdom and values cultivated over the years have not been lost or wasted.

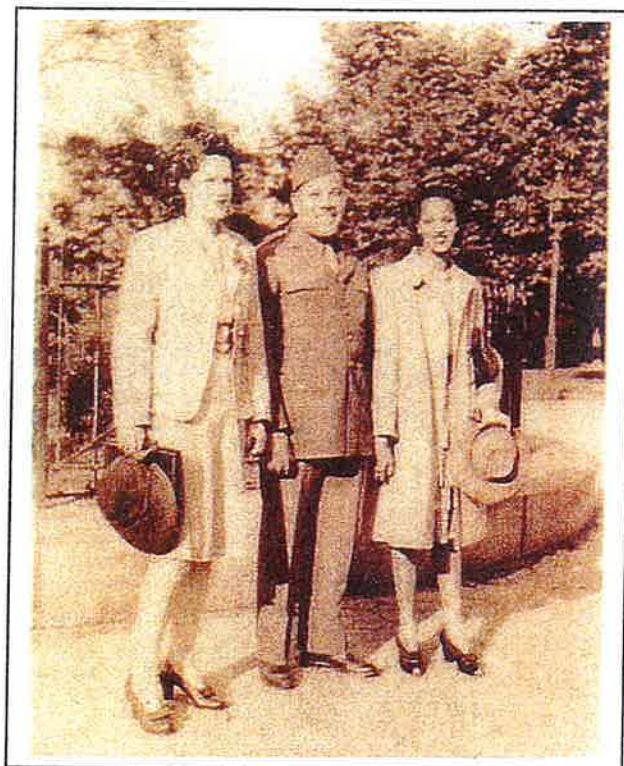

(History of Conway)

Conway

Conway was settled around 1835. It was then known as Martin's Crossroads, also called Kirby.

The year of 1885 brought a railroad to Kirby. The railroad stretched from Boxkins, Va., to Lewiston, and a small depot was built for each community. The conductor of the train decided that the depot at Kirby should be called Conway, from the name of a relative of a chief railroad official. The government was petitioned that the post office be called Conway also. Kirby became Conway to coincide with the depot.

The first post office was located in Mr. Abner Lassiter's Store in 1876. Mr. Lassiter was the first postmaster.

The train mail clerk, a black, used his influence to have Rachel Vaughan, also a black, appointed as the postmistress of the second post office. It was located in her home, a few miles outside of Conway.

After three months, the post office was moved to the store of William T. Bridgers, who was appointed postmaster. The name was changed from Kirby to Conway Post Office at that time.

The first school in the Kirby-Conway area was called Grange Hall School. The second was called Log College, whose first teacher was Miss Crump, grandmother of E. W. Martin. The third was a wooden two-story building located where Floods Funeral Home is now. The fourth school was a two story brick building which is now Conway Elementary.

Conway has had several doctors to serve their community. Possibly the first was Dr. D. H. Reid; Dr. Paul Clifton Brittle, Dr. Joseph Anderton Fleetwood, and Dr. Joseph Anderton Fleetwood, Jr., have followed him.

Conway's authors and writers have been Dr. and Mrs. R. Kelly White and Dr. and Mrs. Gilbert Stephenson. Its contributions to the House of Representatives of N. C. have been the Hon. R. Jennings White, Hon. John Raynor Woodard, and Hon. J. Gray Revelle. Conway has also produced many fine attorneys at law including R. Jennings White, Edgar W. Martin, Russell H. Johnson, Russell H. Johnson, Jr., Bruce C. Johnson, Dr. Gilbert Stephenson, and Judge Perry W. Martin.

The mills and ponds about the area are Stephenson-Sykes Mill and Pond, DeBerry's Mill and Pond, Vaughan's Mill, and Doo Little Pond.

When Gov. Robert Glen went to speak at Conway in 1907, there was no band for the occasion, but almost overnight one was formed by Milton Flythe. The band became famous as the Conway Cornet Band and for several years played for public events far and wide.

Conway was incorporated in 1913. The first Mayor was Mr. Jim Parker. Mr. W. A. Davis was the first policeman. The population was 400. It is now over 900.

Conway never had any hotels or taverns although Mr. Abner Lassiter's home served as hotel to salesmen and other travelers passing through the town.

Kirby Township Goes Back to Early 1700's

THE OWL'S NEST by Nancy M. Froelich

OLD KIRBY CREEK has been quite a factor in Northampton in its day. Even now, it can boast of three sites-DeBerry's, Stephenson-Sykes', and Watson's. The mill I believe the mill at Watson's has been completely abandoned.

THE NAME "KIRBY" AS A family name has not been prevalent in Northampton for quite a long time. I often wondered how the large township, and second largest creek, in the County, acquired that name. Well, at last curiosity has paid off, as the following article, taken from the September 20, 1906, *Roanoke-Chowan Times* tells the story.

"ONE OF THE TOWNSHIPS in Northampton County named Kirby Township. This township lies on the East side of the County next to Murfreesboro Township in Hertford County. A part of the dividing line between Hertford County and Northampton County is along the run of Turkey Creek and Turkey Branch. The latter in ancient times called Turkey Creek. This stream is on the east of the Meredith Watson tract of land. The name Kirby is derived from the Kirby family who lived and owned much of the lands along these creeks."

"IN 1712, THOMAS Kirby, Sr. received a patent for 1,200 acres of land lying on the Hertford side of Turkey Creek. In 1713 Kirby conveyed to Henry Wheeler 100 acres of this patent lying on Turkey Creek and on the west side of the Meherrin River. One of the witnesses to this was Richard Washington. On July 14, 1716, Thomas Kirby and wife appointed their son, Thomas Kirby, Jr., attorney to acknowledge the execution of this deed."

The Martins of Martin's Crossroads-- Now Known as Conway

A Civil War map in the Library of Congress, Washington, D. C., shows Martin's Crossroads where the town of Conway now is. It acquired its present name when the Seaboard Airline Railroad came through the town.

A deed in Northampton County Courthouse records the purchase of land by JOHN MARTIN in 1744. He purchased other lands and received, in 1762, a land grant of 675 acres on Patty's Delight Creek from Earl Granville, one of the Eight Lords Proprietors of Carolina. The site of Patty's Delight Creek is shown on local maps and the present Robert M. Martin Farm is a part of this original land.

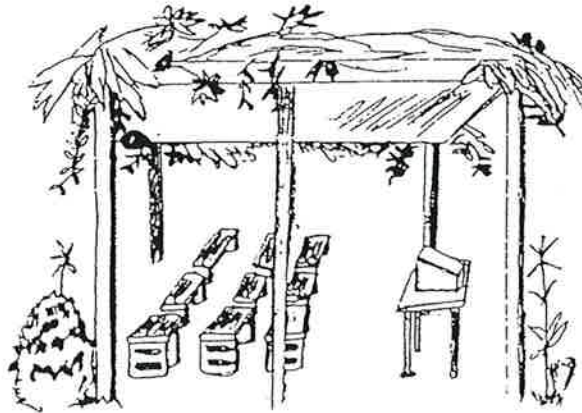
John Martin, Jr., was born around the time of the Revolutionary War. Their children were Maury, Jonathan, and Kinchen. Kinchen, born 1811-died 1884, was buried in the Martin cemetery just west of Conway. He was the father of 12 children. His home, now dismantled, was built prior to 1850 near the present cemetery. Eleven children were born in this home.

(History of Zoar Baptist Church)

HISTORY

The history of Zoar Baptist Church is long according to the history of the free Black man in the South. This church started as a small congregation which worshiped under large oak trees and bush arbors somewhere in the vicinity of the present edifice. In 1865, W. T. Britt gave an acre of land on which to build a church. He was a former slave owner, who lived on the site of John (Dan) Dickerson's estate. On June 1, 1870, according to the record in the Registrar of Deeds Office, the trustees of the church bought the acre of land in order to get a clear deed. The trustees in 1870 were Albert Martin, Isaac Stephenson, and Malachi Deberry. The trustees realized that one acre would not be enough land for expansion, so a second acre was purchased April 22, 1893, W. T. Britt et. ux. to Mark Stephenson, Senor Cowans, and Sipe Deloatch, trustees of Zoar Baptist Church.

ARTIST'S CONCEPT OF BUSH ARBOR

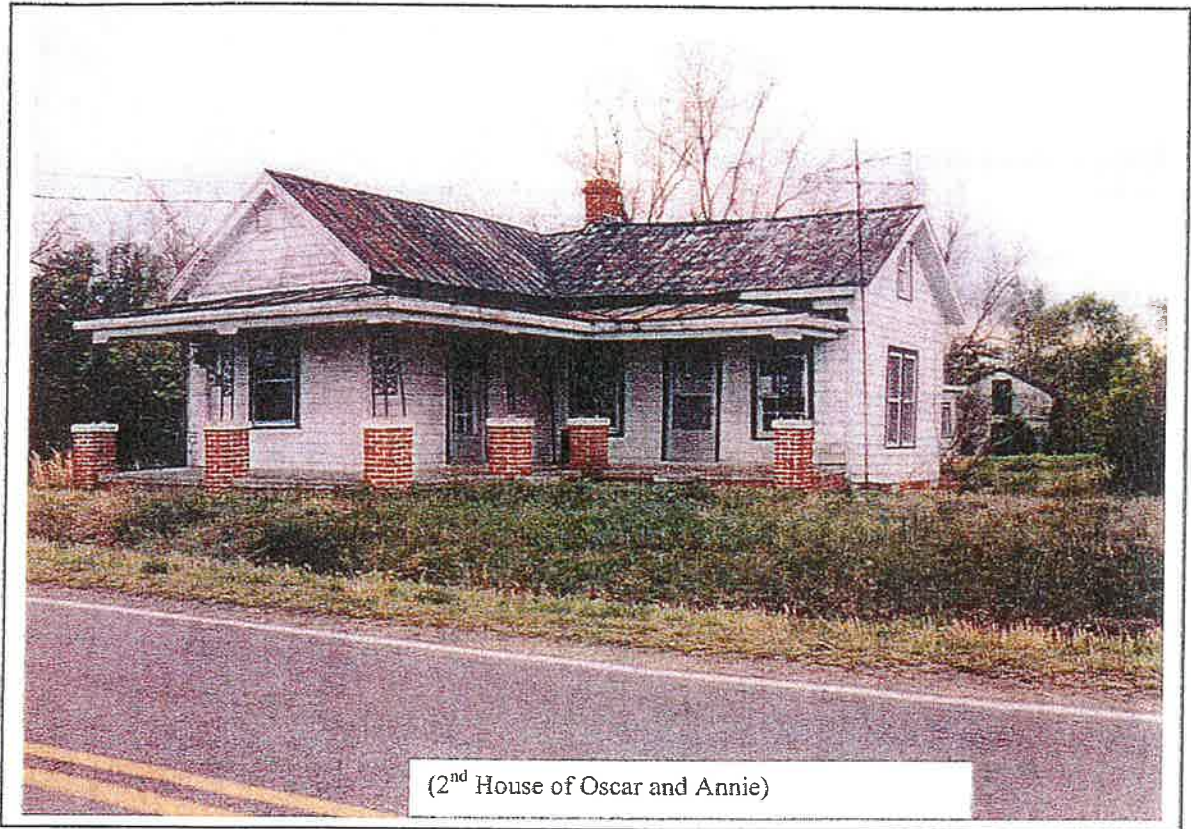
On June 15, 1920, a third acre was purchased from a group who owned the Deberry mill site; they were A W

Carter, L. J. Daye, Henry Edwards, N. T. Calvert, J. T. Foriest, and J. S. Sills, to the trustees: Albert Maddrey, King Dickerson, and Oscar Wood. Three acres comprise the present site.

No one is quite sure who gave the church its name, but "Zoar" is mentioned in four chapters of the Old Testament. They are Genesis 14:2, 8; Genesis 19:20-23; Isaiah 15:5; Jeremiah 48:34. It is surmised that someone named the church from one of those sources.



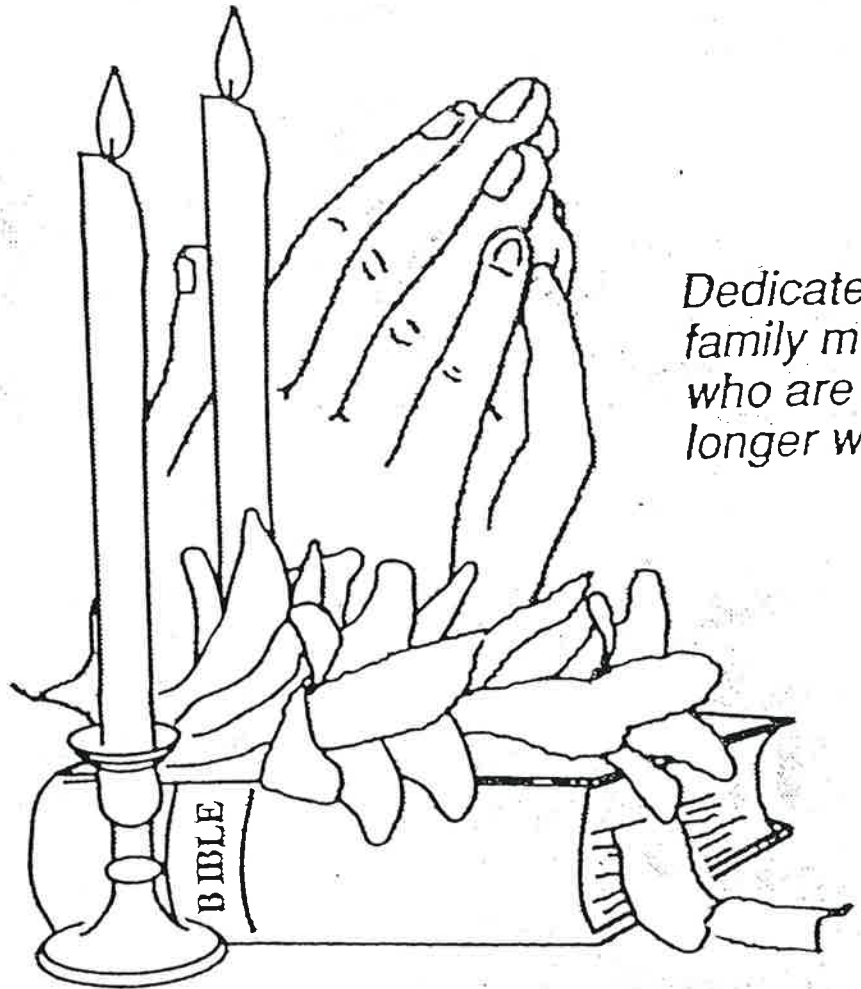
Zoar Baptist Church

(Burial Site of first four of the twelve children)

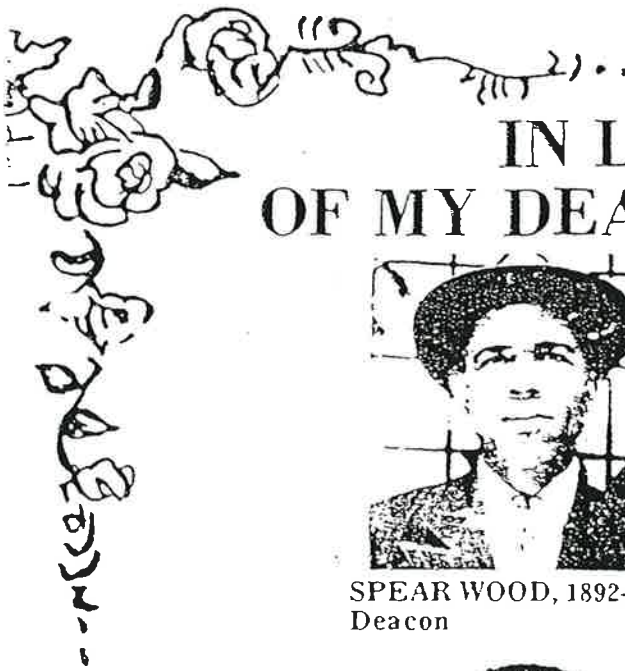

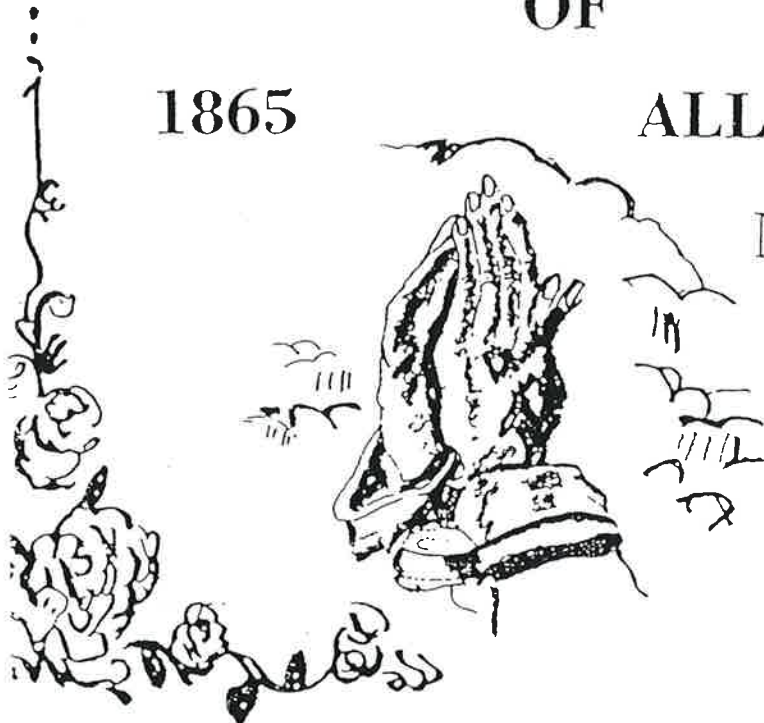

LINEAGE AND DESCENT IN GENEALOGY

Children of your mother and father are your **BROTHER** and **SISTER**. Any children legally adopted by your parents are also your **BROTHER** and/or **SISTER**. Your **SECOND COUSIN** is your grandparents's brother's (or sister's) grandchild. That second cousin's child is your **SECOND COUSIN ONCE REMOVED**; his child is your **SECOND COUSIN TWICE REMOVED**, and so on.

And you **THIRD COUSIN** is your great-grandparent's brother's (or sister's) great-grandchild. The third cousin's child is your **THIRD COUSINS ONCE REMOVED**, his child is your **THIRD COUSIN TWICE REMOVED**.
